








How to add an image gallery to your website



- 1 Login to the admin panel of your website. Look for the 'Galleries' tab and click on it.




2 Selecting the Gallery Code.







In the 'Included Code' column, find the gallery you'd like to add to a page.

Highlight and select the code next to the desired gallery.

Right-click on the code and choose 'Copy' or use the 'Command + C' keyboard shortcut to copy it.



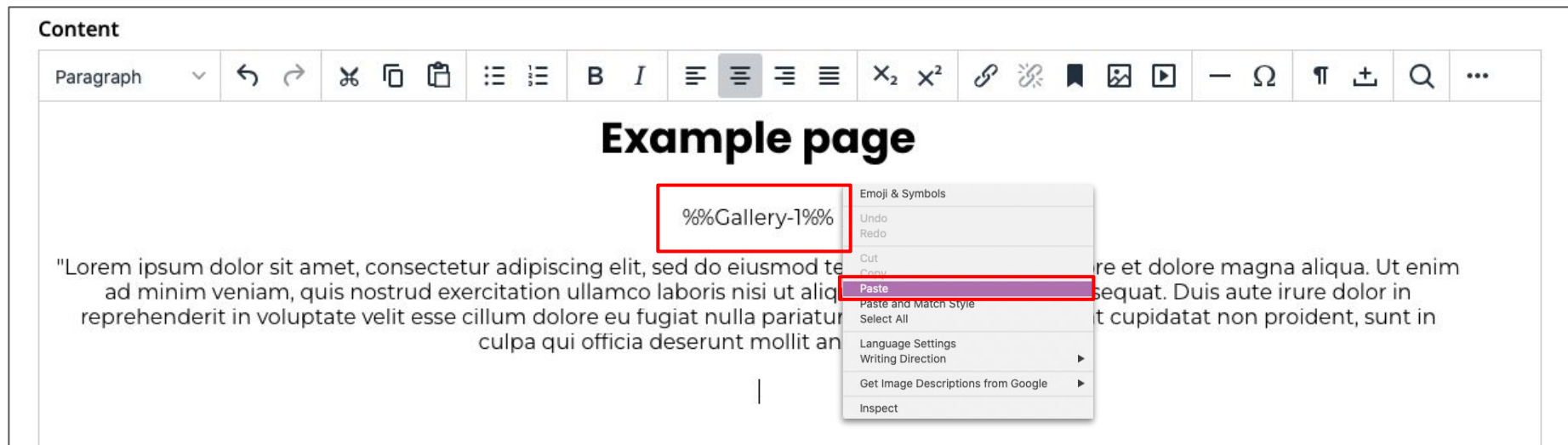

Add the Gallery Code.

Right-click inside the content section of the page where you'd like the gallery to appear. Choose **'Paste'** to insert the copied code into the page. Save the page after pasting the code.



5 Saving and Reviewing Changes.

Refresh the browser window of your live website to see the updated changes, including your newly added gallery.



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
