KEYWORDS AND PHRASES

- Mail application: The program on your computer or mobile device used for managing emails.
- **Finder:** The application on your Mac used for browsing files and folders.
- Email Address: Your unique identifier for receiving and sending emails.
- **Username:** Your email account's unique identifier, typically the same as your email address.
- Password: The secret code used to access your email account.
- Account Type: The protocol used to retrieve emails, such as IMAP or POP.
- Incoming Mail Server: The server responsible for receiving your incoming emails.
- Outgoing Mail Server: The server responsible for sending your outgoing emails.
- Server Details: Information required to connect to the email server, including hostname and port.
- **Preferences:** Customizable settings for your Mail application.
- Port: A number used to establish a connection between your device and the email server.
- Edit Server Settings: Modifying the configurations of the email server for improved performance.
- Automatically Manage Connection Settings: Enabling or disabling the automatic management of connection settings.
- Verification: Confirming the accuracy of the email settings and establishing a successful connection.
- Sign In: Logging into your email account.
- Switched On: Ensuring the Mail app is enabled and ready to receive and send emails.



Locate the Mail application on your Mac. You can search for it in Finder.

Click the Finder application, which looks like a blue square with a smiley face on it.


In the Applications folder, scroll down and find Mail. Click on it to open the Mail application.

If you are not prompted with the 'Choose Mail Account Provider' screen, proceed to Step 3. Select 'Other' from the Mail Account Provider list and click 'Continue.'

Enter your full email address and password.

Your email login details can be sent to your personal email or provided by ActiveHost support over the phone. Then click 'Sign In.'








Enter the server details as directed:

- **Email Address:** Enter your full email address, including what comes after the '@' symbol.
- **Username:** Enter your full email address again.
- **Password:** Enter the password sent to you with your login details for your email.
- Account Type: Choose IMAP or POP depending on your preference.
- **Incoming Mail Server:** This is your incoming server host name.
- Outgoing Mail Server: This is your outgoing server host name.

Please check your login details provided by ActiveHost to ensure you enter the correct email server details.






Once you're logged in, it's important to edit the server settings. Go to Mail > Preferences at the top of your Mac's screen.

Underneath 'Incoming Mail Server (IMAP)' settings, untick the box that says 'Automatically manage connection settings.'


Repeat the same step for 'Outgoing Mail Server (SMTP)' settings.
